### **Detail Itinerary**

**Day 1** - Arrive in Dibrugarh and transfer to hotel. A safety brief by the tour leader will be conducted in the afternoon. Overnight at the luxury Dibrugarh Club House or Tea Country Resort.

**Day 2** – Ride to Boggey Beel ghat. Ride the old-fashioned motorized wooden ferry to cross the Brahmaputra and ride further to Passighat.

**Day 3** – Along is the headquarters of the West Siang District. Along is situated in a picturesque valley at the confluence of Sipu and Siyom rivers.

**Day 4** – Menchuka valley is one of the most beautiful parts of Arunachal Pradesh. Menchukha which means "medicinal water" is a hidden jewel inhabited by the colourful Memba and Boker tribes. Stay overnight at the tribal homestay.

**Day 5** - Explore Menchuka and its surrounding areas to appreciate nature's bounty and the local Memba cultures.

**Day 6** – Move to Ori Village near Along. The unique villages have only 10 Adi families still immersed in their traditional cultures and customs. Each house represents the unique traditional organic architecture and is decorated with hunting trophies and indigenous hunting weapons. Overnight at a village homestay.

**Day 7** – Today we explore Along valley. The beautiful valley locked by mountains on all sides is a beautiful place crisscrossed by the Yomgo River which ultimately converges with the Sipu River. One of the closest tourist destinations is the Patum Bridge.

**Day 8** – Basar Valley, the village has a small population of Gallo tribes living in perfect harmony with the surrounding natural environment. It is named after the highest mountain in the world-"The Everest".

**Day 9** – After breakfast ride starts for Dibrugarh via Shilapathar. The trip ends with a farewell dinner consisting of recipes representing Assam's famous culinary heritage.

**Day 10** - Transfer to Dibrugarh airport.
